

Study in Georgia for International Students

Georgia can be considered affordable for international students with a climbing trend in the quality of education. There are Tbilisi State University offers programs in the fields of medicine, and Ilia State University offers programs in the fields of engineering among others. Tuition fee varies between 3,000 USD and 7,000 USD for an academic year. The low cost of living in Georgia coupled with the easily approachable nature of the people to foreigners is likely to attract Pakistani students.

Prepare Your Documents:

- Academic transcripts
- Personal statement
- Letters of recommendation
- language proficiency in the English language (if necessary)
- CV/Resume

Submit Your Application:

- By personal submission on the university's Online Application platform, or Georgia's Higher Education Commission online application platform.

Receive an Offer:

- Conditional or unconditional offer based on the student's academic achievement.

Accept the Offer:

- Go to the specific university portal to accept your offer.

Apply for a Student Visa:

- Gather required documents: offer letter, proof of financial means, and passport.
- To get a student visa one has to complete an online form through Georgia's Visa Application Centre.

Arrange Accommodation:

- Rent a house either through the university or acquire a personal house.

Prepare for Arrival:

- Complete the travel arrangements and make sure you have the papers for entering the country.

Gather Required Documents:

Acceptance letter from a Georgian university.

- Proof of financial means.
- Academic transcripts and certificates.
- Valid passport.
- Health insurance.

Apply Online:

- Complete the student visa application through the Georgian Ministry of Foreign Affairs website.

Pay the Visa Fee:

- Pay the visa application fee.

Book an Appointment:

- Book an appointment at the Georgian Embassy or Consulate.

Attend the Appointment:

- Submit your application and biometric data.

Wait for Decision:

- Wait for the processing of your visa application.

Receive Your Visa:

- Collect your student visa from the embassy or consulate.
